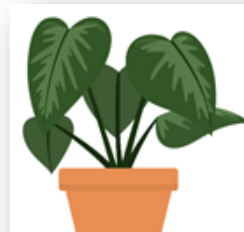


Well done to Ramsey from Y4 for being awarded a Blue Peter badge.
